

Special Life Time Achievement Awardee

Dr. Brijesh Dixit, IRSE

Born on 2nd September 1958, Er. Brijesh Dixit graduated in Civil Engineering in 1980 from MACT (Now MANIT) Bhopal with brilliant academic record and entered elite Indian Railways in February 1982 through IRSE (Indian Railway Services of Engineers). He was awarded Ph. D in "Economics of Railway Safety" by University of Mumbai.



He was associated with Indian Railway for over 36 years including association with Mumbai suburban and urban rail transport for over 20 years, at various levels covering planning, designing, constructing and maintaining large scale rail infrastructures & operation of services and administration of institutions on both Western and Central Railways and now Metro Rail.

He has rendered his excellent services for Indian railways at high ranking profile as below :

- Chief Safety Officer at Indian Railways, January 2006 - March 2008
- Chief Engineer Construction at Indian Railways, April 2008 - October 2011
- Divisional Railway Manager, Nagpur - Central Railway, October 2011 - January 2014
- Chief Track Engineer, Western Railway, March 2014 – December 2014

On his outstanding performance during above period, he was appointed as Managing Director, Maharashtra Metro Rail Corporation Limited in February 2015. He was entrusted with the responsibility of implementation of all Metro projects in the State of Maharashtra outside Mumbai Metropolitan Region. Currently implementing Metro Rail Project at Nagpur and Pune.

Key Achievements for Nagpur Metro under dynamic leadership of Er. Brijesh Dixit :

- 13.7 km section from Khapri to Sitabuldi Interchange was inaugurated on 7th March 2019 by Hon. Prime Minister through VC
- 11km section from Lokmanya Nagar to Sitabuldi Interchange was inaugurated on 28th January 2020 by Hon. Chief Minister (Maharashtra), H'ble Union Minister for RT&H and MSME, H'ble MoS (I/C) for HUA, Civil Aviation and Commerce and Industry.
- 1.6km section from Sitabuldi Interchange to Kasturchand Park was inaugurated on 20th August 2021 by Hon. Chief Minister (Maharashtra), H'ble Union Minister for RT&H and Hon. Union Minister for HUA and Petroleum & Natural Gas.

- Maha Metro set a record of completing 25km stretch in 50 months thereby setting a benchmark of completion of 1km viaduct in 2 months.
